Systems Upgrades

- PABX replaced by VoIP solution
 - One-to-one replacement completed
 - Preparing SIP server integration
- Network equipment replacement
 - PowerOverEthernet switches for the PABX are in place
 - Most switches for servers are replaced
 - Tests and configuration of the network are done
 - Now doing risk analysis, and planning for replacing the core network
- Ticketing system replacement
 - Prototyping phase
 - Integration planning
