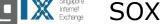

Technical session 1

- Security for IXPs (Che-Hoo Cheng)
 - Che-Hoo raised concerns about tapping or backdoor at IXP infrastructure, and we discussed various perspectives of security at IXPs.
 - Will document a guideline for IXP security.
- SLA for IXPs (Raphael Ho)
 - Raf asked questions regarding SLA of each IXP, and we discussed whether SLA is measured or not, what and how to measure, and how to visualize.
 - Will document the criteria for measurement and SLA
- Experience of CISCO router as a route server (Yoshiki Ishida)
 - JPIX replaced its route servers from Quagga to CISCO IOS-XE.



Technical Session 2

- Presentation from potential patrons
 - AJ of Alcatel-Lucent presented IXP architecture using MPLS technology, and its example (DE-CIX)
 - Iann of Juniper introduced IXP architecture using MPLS-TE/VPLS, and its example (LINX)
 - Vincent of Google gave a talk on their vision and the reasons to promote IXPs.
- IXP updates
 - VNIX, IIX, NZIX, NIXI, NPIX, HKIX



Administrative session

- Legal entity of APIX
 - Rough consensus on exploring the possibilities that our legal entity is under APIA
- APIX website
 - Does not work well now, needs improvement.
 - Discuss with Euro-IX, whether to use their software or to store our data on their platform as well as their data.
- ITU's definition of IXP
 - At IX-F (Global IX Federation), ITU's activity to define IXP was introduced. Here we also discussed their purposes and intention.
 - Will investigate it, and make comments if necessary.
