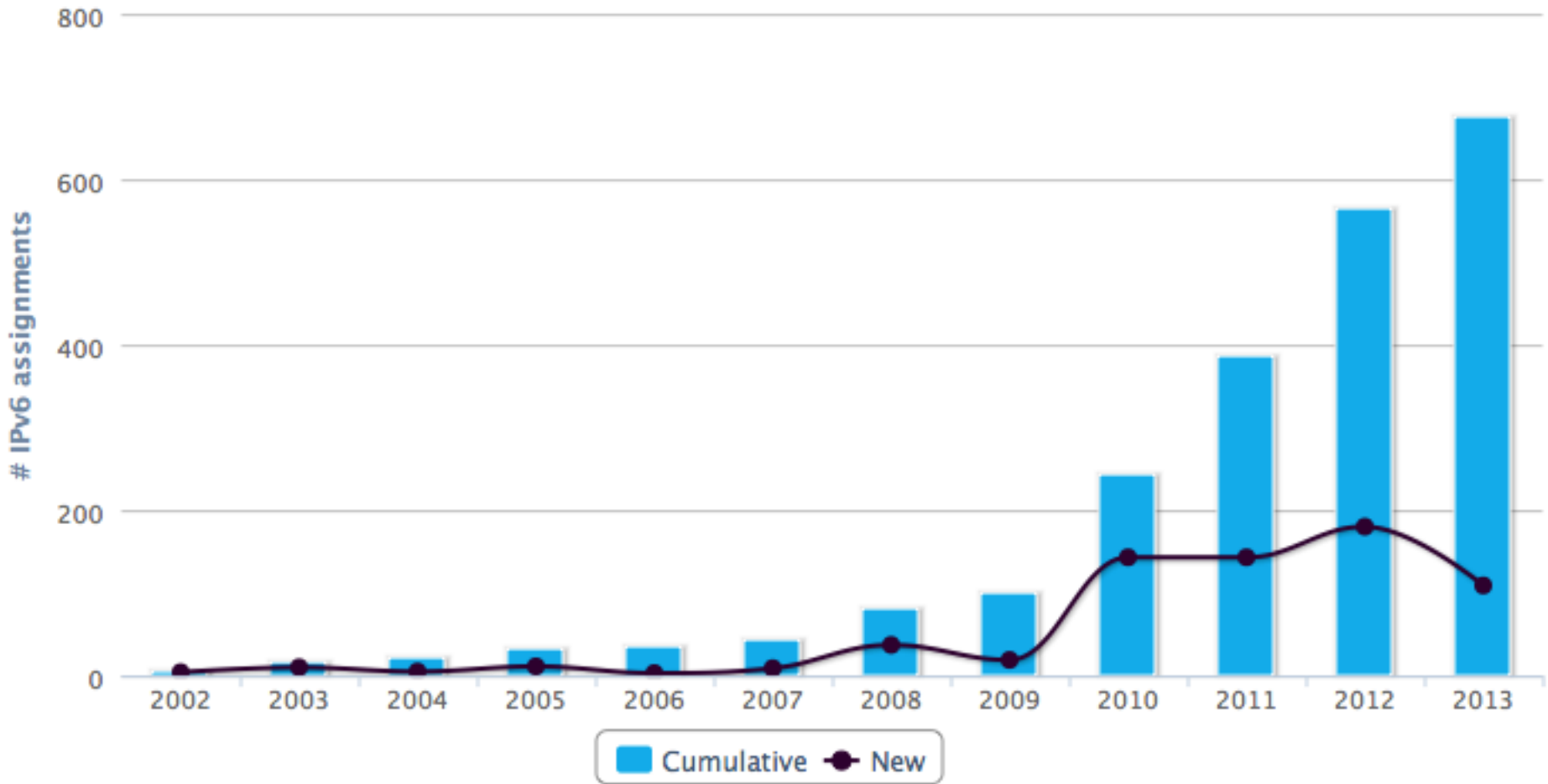

  - When the first RIR reaches a /9



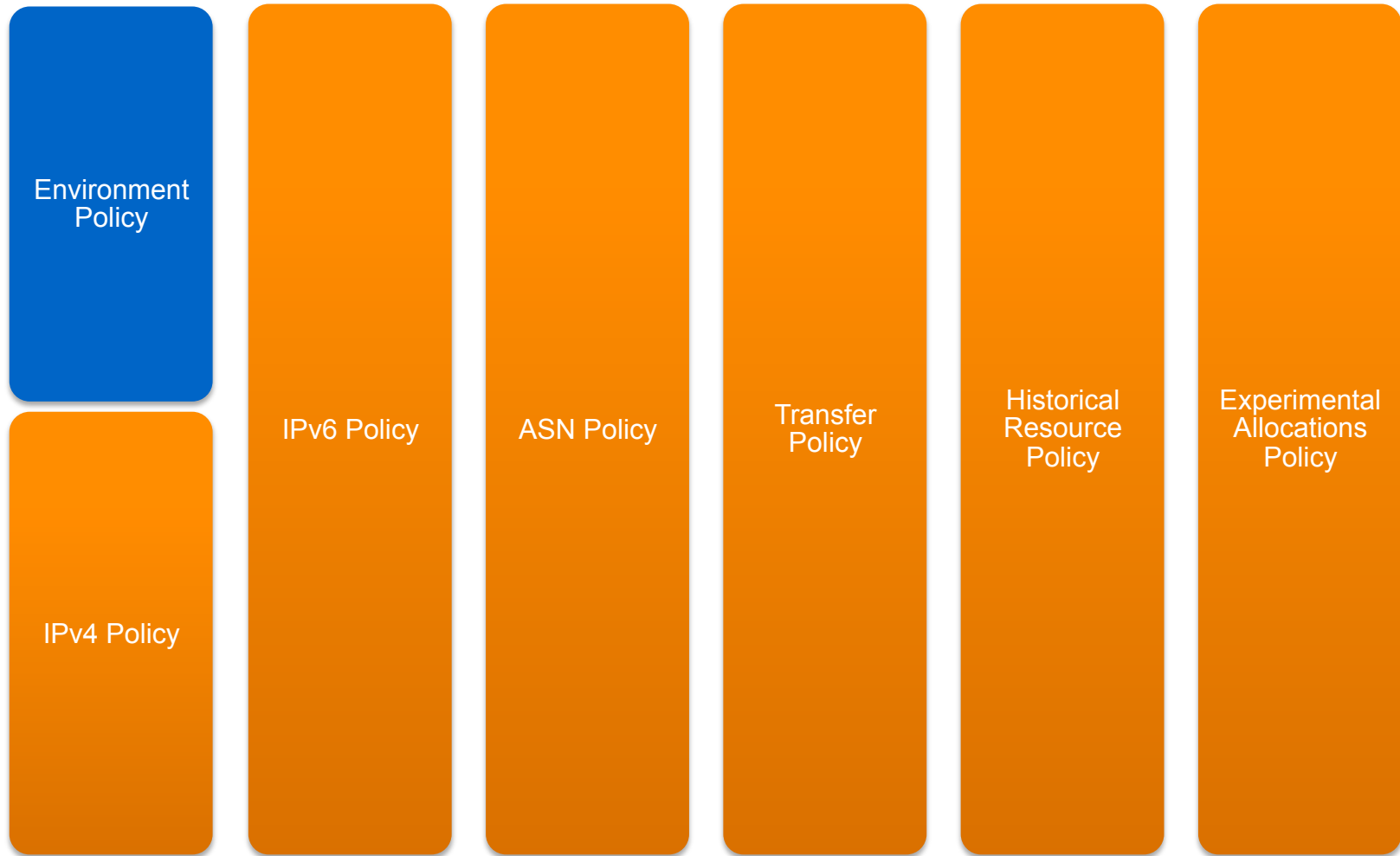
