#### Typically, leasing...

- Involves
  - Lessor: implied ownership of asset
  - Lessee: pays for right to use asset

- Includes real or implied rights
  - Lessor rights for return of asset in good condition
  - Lessee rights as to the serviceability and free use of the asset



## IPv4 Leasing: is it happening?

  - IPv4 Market Group: "Lease to Own" <a href="http://is.gd/yYYdvk">http://is.gd/yYYdvk</a>

- Why should we care?
  - Preserve registry integrity
  - Ensure addresses are routable

Should we start thinking about this?





#### Some observations

- Policy
  - Current APNIC policy doesn't deal with this
  - If it should, what changes need to be made?
- Registration
  - How can leasing agreements be properly registered?
  - Significantly more complex in an inter-regional context
- Routability
  - APNIC Routing Registry (IRR)
  - Whois-based filtering
- Member Services
  - Access to MyAPNIC
  - Fees and membership
