Introduction

Event Description

The APNIC Open Policy Meeting is a regular and major developmental forum within the Asia Pacific Internet community, particularly in the areas of infrastructure management and technical policy. It is marketed to and attended by the membership of APNIC (which comprises over 800 major ISPs across 46 economies) as well as members of the broader technical and policy community of the region and the world.

About APNIC

APNIC is one of four Regional Internet Registries in the world and is responsible for the distribution and management of numeric Internet address space in the Asia Pacific region. As a membership organisation comprised of most of the region's ISPs, it is the primary source of operational services, policies, and training related to the management of IP address space in the region. Furthermore, as a respected and authoritative voice in the Internet community, APNIC represents this region in the development of global Internet policy.

Fellowship Programme

A portion of sponsorships (15 %) will be allocated to the APNIC 16 fellowship programme. The programme encourages members of the Internet community from developing economies in the Asia Pacific region to attend the meeting. It targets key staff from organisations developing or providing Internet services, in particular, those responsible for managing Internet resources (such as IP addresses, autonomous system numbers, and routing registry data). The meeting host (KRNIC) and APNIC will also contribute to the fellowship fund.

Fellows will receive financial assistance towards attendance at APNIC 16, accommodation, and meal and incidental costs. To provide additional support for travel expenses APNIC is also seeking funding from the World Banks's infoDev (Information for Development) programme.

Why Sponsor the 16th APNIC Open Policy Meeting?

APNIC Open Policy Meetings provide substantial benefits to the Asia Pacific Internet community. However, as a non-profit organisation, fully funded by membership contributions, APNIC relies on strategic sponsorships to assist it in fulfilling its role.

A maximum of 3 platinum sponsorships are available for the duration of the 16th APNIC Open Policy Meeting.

- Minimum of 50 wireless network cards, for loan to conference attendees (on receipt of a security deposit equal to a discounted sale price).
- 5 or more base stations (10Base-T uplink),
- Preferred formats: 'Wavelan', 802.11 2.4 GHz (DS) 11 Mb/s.

3. Internet Connection

Sponsor Commitment

This sponsor is to provide an Internet connection to Lotte Hotel Seoul - Jamsil facilities from Sunday 17 to Friday 22 August and to provide technical assistance as required for installation, configuration and maintenance of the following equipment:

- Internet connection speed 10Mb (minimum),
- Local networks to support IPv4, IPv6 and multicast,
- Nameservers to support IPv6 and IPv4,
- The routers must support both IPv6 over IPv4 tunneling and native IPv6 for Ethernet connectivity,
- Routers to permit local trainers to connect and show BGP state, or provide a local iBGP peer or view of the global routing table,
- Connectivity to a multicast and IPv6 route exchange point to be provided so the meeting is globally visible in IPv4, IPv6 and multicast IP,
- Approximately 48 fixed drops including connections for wireless hubs or switches to permit a significant number of attachments in meeting rooms.
