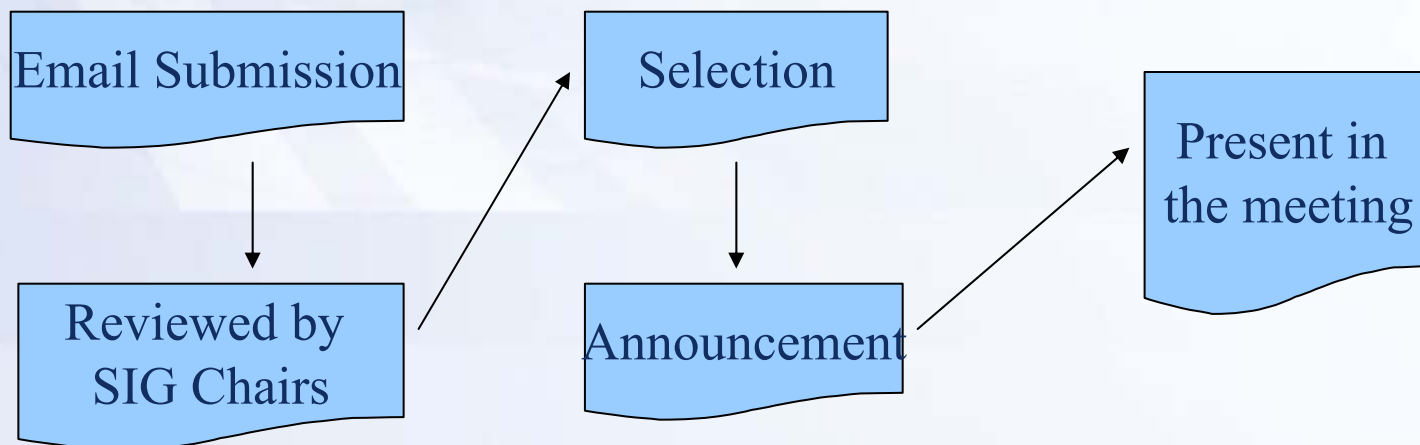

SIG 1: Address SIG

- > Proposal 1, by SeedNet:
Suggestion for ADSL address Assignment policy
Consensus:
 - # 1. Flexible on Criteria for IPv4 subsequent allocations to DSL services
 - # 2. Depending on the used IP address at peak time



SIG 1: Address SIG (cont.)

- > Proposal 2, by NCIC:
Second Opinion Request for Sub-allocation Process Review and Suggestion
Consensus:
 - # 1. Applicants has no Multi-homing requirement
 - # 2. LIR is responsible for WHOIS registration
- > Proposal 3, by SeedNet:
Suggestion for Inter-VPN address assignment policy
Consensus:
 - # 1. No restriction on private IP address
 - # 2. Promotion usage on public IP address

SIG 2: DB SIG

- > Proposal 1, by TTN:
Suggest a new Whois query structure
Consensus :
 - # 1. Need more discussion on new architecture
 - # 2. Open Client/Server source to public
- > Proposal 2, by TTN:
Legitimate and validity of Whois DB data disclosure
Consensus :
 - # 1. More discussion on protection or disclosure ISP infrastructure information

> Proposal, by HiNet

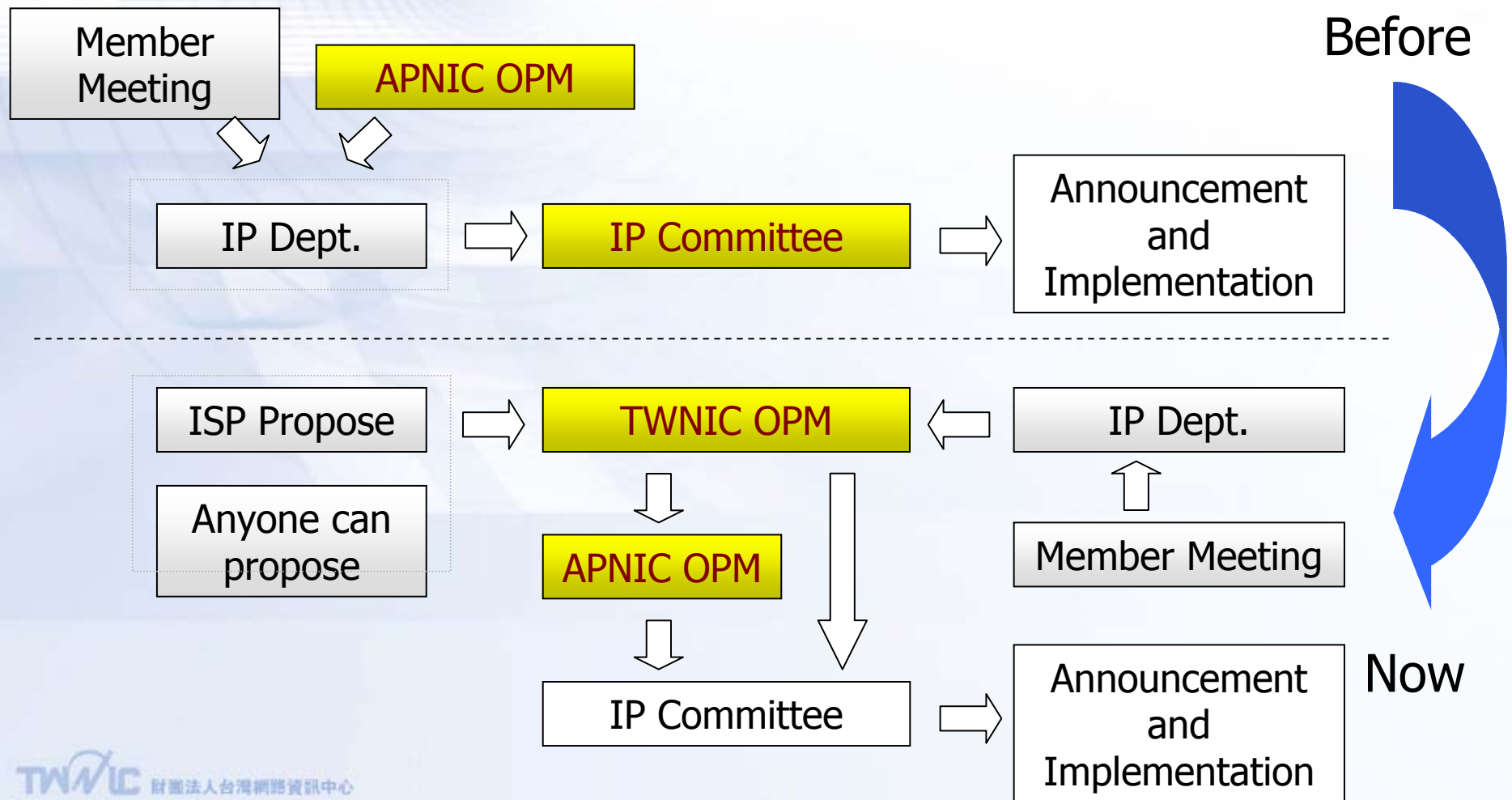
Discussion on Open routing table lookup

Consensus :

1. Suggest to establish a platform for LIRs operator to check opened Looking Glass when network disconnect

- > 1. SIG-Address
 - > Proposal : A proposal to modify subsequent allocation criteria
 - > Author : Lee Yi Digital United Inc. Taiwan
- > 2. SIG-DB
 - > Proposal : A proposal for whois db query
 - > Author : Jeng-jr Li TTN / PCCW Taiwan

Conclusion and thoughts

- > Over 80 attended OPM, successfully set up a new milestone of Taiwan Internet resource allocation policy making
- > A lot more discussion than expected
- > Internet policy should be made by everyone, not any Internet Registry
