Background

- Objective
 - Registration in DB accurate and current
 - Reduce unauthorised use of Internet resources by spammers and hackers
- Proposal
 - <http://www.apnic.net/docs/policy/proposals/prop-017-v001.html>
 - Reached consensus in APNIC17
 - EC endorsed May 2004
 - Implemented Mar 2005 end Mar 2006



Definitions

- Historical
 - Resources distributed without formal agreement, AUNIC and ERX
- Un-routed
 - Not globally visible since 1998
- Unused
 - Un-routed & not used on closed network



Implementation procedure

- Brief procedure
 - Compile list of affected blocks
 - Allocation/assignment before 1997
 - 203.0.0.0/10 - former AUNIC blocks
 - ERX blocks
 - Consult Prefix Advertisement Database (PAD)
 - Unrouted prefixes since 1998 will be contacted
 - Email, phone and fax as an alternative
 - Repeat the process every 2 months for 1 year
 - Unused prefixes will be recovered




Implementation status

- Implementation in Mar 2005
 - Third emails sent out in Jul 2005
 - 1250
 - Trying to contact custodians without email
 - 217
 - Trying to contact bounced custodian emails
 - 170




Distribution of prefix status
