


# Equinix Exchange - Sydney

- Started in 2003
- 18 Participants
  - Includes domestic/international carriers,
    ISPs, and Content Providers
  - Flat fee structure port
  - FastEthernet Connections
  - Colocation Services 24x7
- Both MLPA and BLPA available
- Neutral
- Proxy peering available




## Traffic Trends - Volume






# Traffic Trends - Peak

# Equinix Exchange Extension

- Extension of the Exchange platform to the second and third largest population centres in Australia, Melbourne and Brisbane
- 3 Sites connected by ethernet backhaul provided by NextGen
  - Equinix Sydney IBX
  - Brisbane Metronode DC
  - Melbourne Metronode DC




## **Equinix Exchange Extension**

- Enables inter-state peering via MLPA
  - Allows peers in each site to access peers in all 3 sites.
  - Intra-site BLPA peering allowed in all 3 sites.
  - No need to pay for inter-state backhaul
  - Larger community of peers
  - Usual case for peering
  - Managed by single entity
- Launch: March 2006
