Motivation

- Amend text of existing IPv6 policy document
 - Clarify policy for IPv6 portable assignments to critical infrastructure networks

Current problem

- Policy statement:
 - “The **minimum** assignment made under these terms is /32”
- Operators of critical infrastructure have requested multiple /32 for multiple POPs or servers providing secondary services
 - Deemed that additional /32 assignments to critical infrastructure operators not conservative

Policy in other RIRs

- AfriNIC - /48 minimum under discussion
- ARIN - /48 minimum assignment per POP
- LACNIC - /48 minimum, /32 maximum per operator
- RIPE NCC - /32 maximum allocation

Proposal

- Modify the statement to:
 - The **maximum** assignment made under these terms is /32 **per operator**
- Avoid ambiguity and ease evaluation
- Implementation:
 - Immediately after endorsement by the Executive Council
