# What is APIX forum?

- “Asia-Pacific Internet Exchange” forum
- A forum of **Internet Exchange Providers** in Asia-Pacific region
- To share information about technical, operational, and business issues and solutions regarding Internet Exchange

# Background

- Internet Exchanges have become very important infrastructure for the Internet.
- Many Internet Exchanges in Asia-Pacific region.
- But no forum of Internet Exchange Providers in **Asia-Pacific**, to share information regarding IX technology, operation, business, and so on.
  - comparing to “Euro-ix” in Europe
