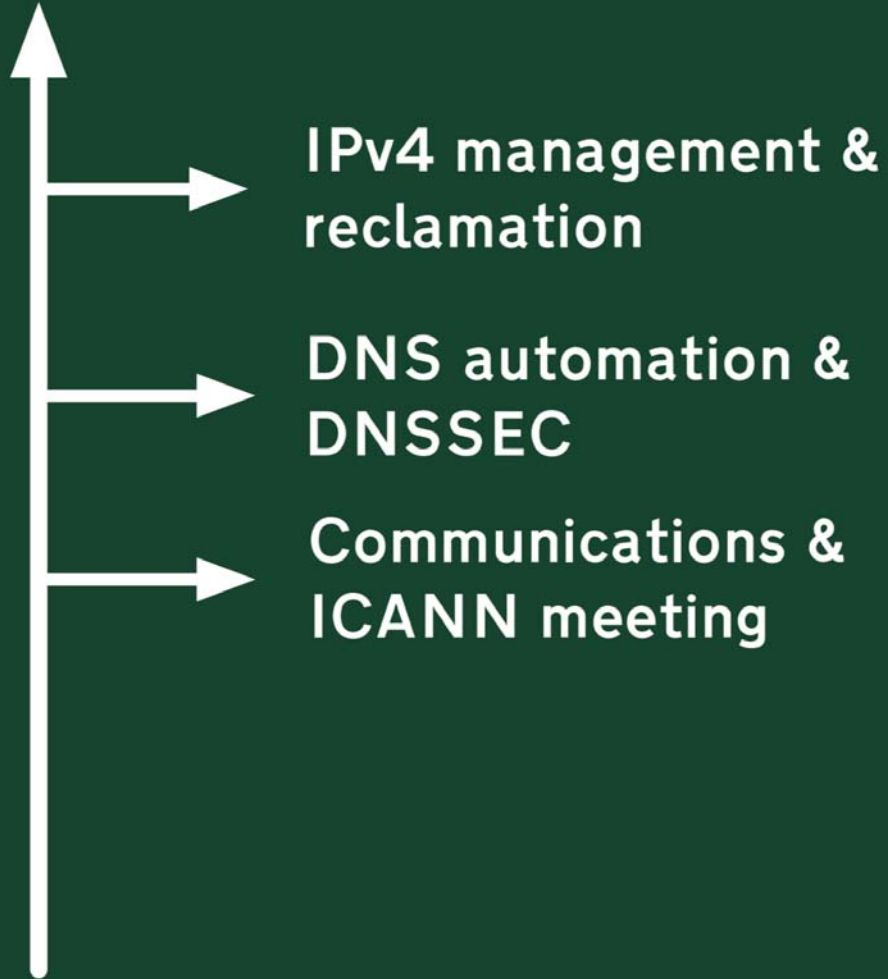

# Throwing Some Back

- We reclaimed 14.0.0.0/8 with the X.25 operator community in 2007
- We have been working with ARIN & the IESG on returning smaller blocks this year, including
  - 192.0.48.0/20
  - 192.0.64.0/18
  - parts of 192.0.0.0/19

# Reverse DNS Management


- Working with the RIRs' technical staff on a new automated system for reverse DNS management
- Includes provisions for securely accepting DNSSEC delegation material from RIRs signing reverse domains
- Systems entered beta testing at the end of July

# DNSSEC in the Root

- Working with various groups on an interim mechanism for DNSSEC in the DNS root later this year
- The ITAR will remain available until a permanent mechanism is agreed and deployed
