- **Global Policy Management**
 - **Global Policy Proposal for the Allocation of IPv4 Blocks to Regional Internet Registries**
 - Adopted in APNIC, LACNIC and final call concluded in AfriNIC.
 - Adopted in ARIN with different text.
 - Under discussion in RIPE.
 - ASO/AC decided this policy proposal failed to get global consensus and advised NRO EC about that.
 - **Global Policy proposal for allocation of ASNs to RIRs**
 - Adopted in APNIC, RIPE and ARIN
 - Waiting for ratification by LACNIC and AfriNIC boards.
