1. World ⇔ Busan

- Japan, China, USA, Taiwan, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, Germany, Russia

2. World ⇔ Incheon ⇔ Busan

- Incheon International Airport : 35 countries, 116 cities,
2,766 flights/week (round trip)
- Incheon ⇔ Busan 6~8 flights/day (round trip)

3. World ⇔ Incheon ⇔ Kimpo ⇔ Busan

- Kimpo ⇔ Busan 60~66 flights (round trip)
every 30~40 min. interval flight service

4. World ⇔ Japan ⇔ Busan

- Japan 5 cities (Tokyo, Osaka, Fukuoka, Nagoya, and Sapporo)
136 flights/week (round trip)

5. World ⇔ China ⇔ Busan

- China 13 cities (Beijing, Shanghai, Hong Kong, and so on)
208 flights/week (round trip)

 - Asia and Oceania(Bangladesh, Israel, Malaysia, New zealand, Pakistan, Singapore, Thailand), Europe(27), Americas(21) etc.
- **Countries or Regions under Principles of Reciprocity and National Interest**
 - Asia(Brunei, Hong kong, Japan, Kuwait, Macao, Oman, Qatar, Saud arabia, Taiwan, United Arab emirates, Yemen), North America(2), South America(7), Europe(8) etc.
