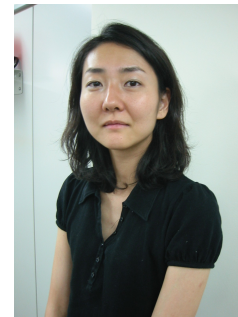

# Major Activities

- CNNIC
  - Conducting research on IP address
    - allocations within a network, security considerations in protocol and revision of IPv6 format
- TWNIC
  - Sharing information to its community to help prepare for IPv6
    - e.g., a list of IPv6 ready products, IPv6 website directory, dedicated website on IPv4 exhaustion
- KRNIC
  - preparing for IPv6 transition as a national plan and has set a flag date as June 2011

# Discussions

- It was suggested that changes in IPv6 format in CNNIC's research should be discussed in the IETF
- KRNIC has set a flag date as a milestone to prepare for IPv6 but it is not a registry's role to speculate the date of APNIC's IPv4 pool exhaustion
- Outreach activities on IANA's IPv4 pool exhaustion was shared and will improve collaboration for the exhaustion of APNIC pool
