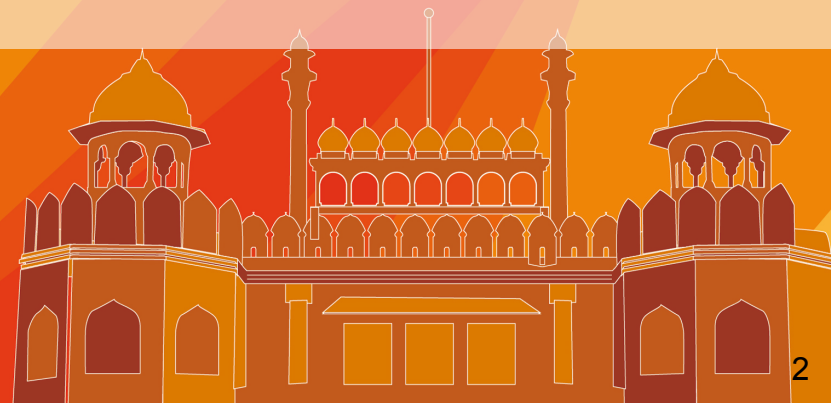

- We as the Internet Community have a long history of sharing information



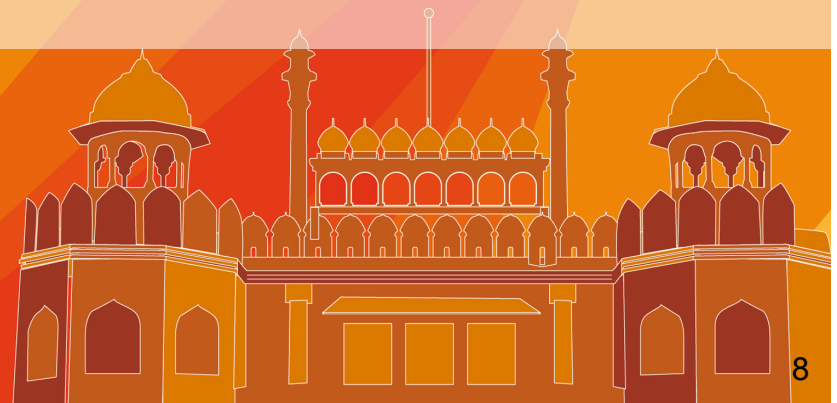
