 - IPv6@APNIC collaboration welcome with NIRs


Future of NIR SIG

- Consider a non-SIG format from APNIC36
 - No proposals since APNIC25 (Feb 2008)
 - Will not change the contents and simply will not be called a SIG – no formalities of elections
 - No opposition expressed at the session
 - Will continue to seek opinions on the mailing list
- Other related discussions
 - Have information exchange based on specific topics:
 IPv6, IPv4 transfers, DNSSEC, RPKI
 - Economies based situation, co-ordination with government
