
APRICOT 2016 Conference Evaluation Survey

All the sessions were really a great opportunity to learn new things. Tutorials, Tecchnical presentations and APNIC sessions was really good.


Too many vendor lighting talks, they should have not been allowed.

Would have been nice to have the closing social somewhere other than the conference venue!


Food and performance at APRICOT Closing Social is great.

The sessions need to be more distributed. Wednesday was packed with more interesting ones and could have been more distributed


It was a great experience to meet up with key players from around the APAC region. There was a strong focus on peering which was good as well.

8. How satisfied were you with your visit to the APNIC Member Services Lounge?





The lack of (indicative) start times for talks within a session also made it difficult to judge whether it was appropriate/possible to enter a room after some other invent (eg, work calling) and see a specific talk.

Website is too hard to navigate - an ongoing problem that never seems to be fixed.

It would help if the APRICOT website would provide some background on the conference itself. What it is meant to be and is trying to achieve.

More details of the intended APOPS presentations need to be made known earlier.

Meeting maker was confusing between two choices, had to use both as not everyone was using both. It would be better to stick with only one option on meeting maker tool.


The agenda was a bit late up on the site so earlier on it wasn't clear what each session meant - APOPS, etc.

There were no programs on peering forum session in advance. Why?


13. Did you use the APRICOT Mobile App?

Got a lot of spam meeting requests.


It had the option of rooms, but no rooms available, it would have been good to organise breakout rooms or at least tables that could be booked for these meetings.

Worked pretty well with colleagues that weren't using any particular IM tool, but we could chat within the app


17. Did you use the APRICOT Meeting Maker (powered by Equinix)?
