Prop-135: Documentation

- Version 1 reached consensus at the OPM and AMM
- Status
 - Implemented on 6 December 2021

This proposal suggested changes to the supporting documentation required for resource requests and to remove any duplication. In the previous policy document, there was repetition in sections 5.6 and 5.6.1 of the Resource Request Supportive Document.



prop-136: Registration Requirements

- Version 1 reached consensus at the OPM and AMM
- Status
 - Implemented on 6 December 2021

In the previous policy document, Section 5.3 was categorized into three subsections (sections 5.3.1, 5.3.2 and 5.3.3) based on each resource type. This proposal suggested combining the individual resource type registration requirements into one section.



prop-138: Restricting AS-ID in ROA

- Version 2 reached consensus to be a guideline at the OPM
- Status
 - Guideline document published on 6 December 2021

This proposal suggested restricting APNIC Members from creating ROAs with private, reserved, or unallocated ASNs, and to reduce mistakenly created bogon ROAs.

prop-139: SOR not required

- Version 1 reached consensus at the OPM and AMM
- Status
 - Implemented on 6 December 2021

This proposal suggested deleting the LIR Second Opinion Request (SOR) process from the policy, which is rarely used. It is no longer required with the exhaustion of IPv4 and is not required with IPv6.



prop-140: Update End-Site definition

- Version 1 reached consensus at the OPM and AMM
- Status
 - Implemented on 6 December 2021

This proposal recommended to clearly defining both 'end-site and 'end-user' in the policy document to avoid any confusion with IPv4 and IPv6 delegations.
