Background

- Trust and accuracy is critical to the operation of a registry
- APNIC's planned delegation reviews began at the end of 2024 to ensure compliance is being maintained with address policy
- Aggregated data analysis - ~10 years of registry delegations and transfers
 - All NIRs and APNIC itself
 - Review data and progress any remediation required
 - APNIC's delegation review findings are preliminary only. They should not be taken to infer that delegations are fraudulent or that there has been any improper actions taken by Members or registry staff
- Supporting activities at APNIC
 - Process reviews and operational improvements

2025 Progress: Aggregated Data Analysis

- JPNIC review completed (February) - no adverse findings
- IDNIC review remediation in progress
 - 102 delegations confirmed to be reclaimed to date
 - APNIC to verify the results
 - Process improvements made
- VNNIC review approaching finalization
 - Temporary Second Opinion Review (SOR) process in place to help ensure alignment and understanding in delegation practices

Future delegation reviews

- Remaining reviews of NIRs and APNIC's own registry to follow in 2026
 - Decision made to extend the delegation review timetable so remediation and SOR workload can be managed without compromising other projects
 - We hope one more NIR delegation review can be completed this year with remainder in 2026

2025 Progress: Supporting Initiatives

- Account accuracy review
 - Proactively assist Members to ensure registry data is accurate
 - To be implemented this year
- Policy and procedure review
 - Changes to team structure completed, review of resource delegation processes and workflows in progress
- Policy compliance spot checks on new APNIC delegations established
- Standard NIR agreement review
 - To commence in 2026 once RIR Governance Document completed (ICP-2)
