

APNIC 60 Policy Implementation Update

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prop-162: WHOIS Privacy

- Version 3 reached consensus at APNIC 60 OPM and AMM
- Status: Technical Implementation complete
- Expected completion: End of Q2 2026

This policy removes the unnecessary publication of APNIC Resource Holder organization contact details (email addresses, telephone numbers, and physical addresses) from any bulk access to WHOIS data.

People with a legitimate need for these contact details can use the WHOIS search facilities (website/WHOIS/RDAP) provided by APNIC



prop-162: WHOIS Privacy

- Technical works are completed
- Awaiting update to AUA
 - Adding clarity
 - General terms to access
 - Permitted use
 - Additional Terms for Bulk Whois



prop-162: WHOIS Privacy

- Process for Notification
 - All current Bulk WHOIS users will be notified by email
 - New AUA to be signed
 - New Logins assigned
 - Old Logins Removed



prop-166: Revocation of Persistently Non-functional RPKI Certification Authorities

- Version 1 reached consensus at APNIC 60 OPM and AMM
- Status: Technical Implementation complete
- Expected Completion: End of Q2 2026

This policy requires that APNIC revoke the RPKI certificate for any Self-Hosted Certification Authority(CA) that has not updated their manifest or Certification Revocation List(CRL) for longer than 2 months.



prop-166: Revocation of Persistently Non-functional RPKI Certification Authorities

- Technical works completed and monitoring now in place
- Escalation flow
 - 30 days - email notification
 - 50 days – Direct contact
 - 60 days – Revocation of CA Delegation
- Finalising RPKI ToC



prop-167: Published Statistics on Directory Service Usage

- Version 2 reached consensus at APNIC 60 OPM and AMM
- Status: In Implementation
- Expected completion: **By the end of Q2**

This policy requires APNIC to provide Resource Holders and other stakeholders with visibility into the use of WHOIS and RDAP services.

APNIC will publish the statistics about Directory Services usage in a machine-readable format for consumption by interested parties.
