Proposed Revision of the Charter

- The charter of the NIR SIG is to share information relating to the operations, policies, and procedures of National Internet Registries, promote cooperation among NIRs and with the APNIC Secretariat, ***and provide a forum for sharing best current practices and supporting the effective implementation of policies. It also fosters networking and collaboration among NIRs, supports the development of a strong and collaborative NIR community, and identifies issues of common interest, consolidates views and suggestions from NIRs and NIR members, and, where appropriate, communicates them to the APNIC Executive Council for consideration.***

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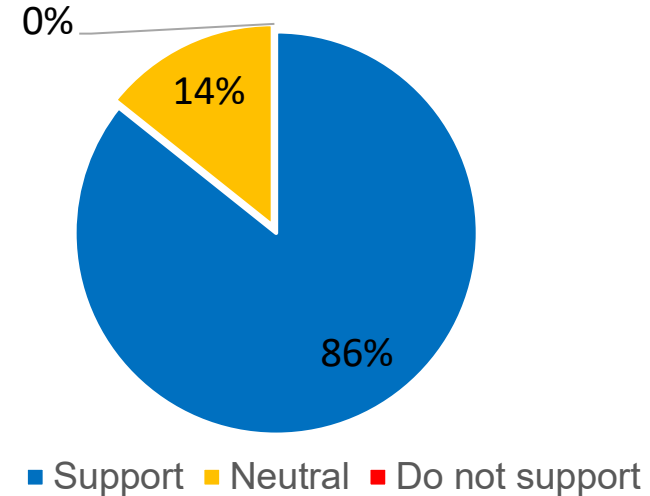
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Key Points of the Proposed Revision of the Charter

1. Sharing information and best current practices
2. Providing a forum for collaboration and discussion on operational and policy issues
3. Supporting the effective implementation of policies
4. Building a strong and collaborative NIR community and strengthening engagement among NIRs
5. Identifying issues of common interest and conveying suggestions to the APNIC Executive Council (EC), where appropriate, for consideration
